

CAPITAL CITY CLAIM (CCC) MECHANISM

IN PARALLEL WITH THE LANDRUSH PERIOD, THE APPLICANT WILL IMPLEMENT A CAPITAL CITY CLAIM (CCC) SERVICE WHEREBY ADDITIONAL PROTECTION WILL BE GRANTED TO THE CAPITAL CITY NAMES OF A COUNTRY OR TERRITORY LISTED IN THE ISO 3166-1 STANDARD. A HIGH LEVEL DESCRIPTION OF HOW THE CCC PROCESS WILL OPERATE IS AS SET OUT BELOW:

NOTIFICATION



A PROSPECTIVE DOMAIN NAME REGISTRANT SEEKING TO REGISTER A DOMAIN NAME IDENTICAL TO A CAPITAL CITY OF A COUNTRY OR TERRITORY (LISTED IN THE ISO 3166-1 STANDARD) WILL BE NOTIFIED BY THE APPLICANT OF THIS MATCH THROUGH A CCC NOTIFICATION



AGREEMENT



IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO REGISTER THE DOMAIN IN QUESTION, A PROSPECTIVE REGISTRANT WHO RECEIVES A CCC NOTIFICATION MUST COMPLY WITH THE WARRANTIES SET OUT THEREIN TO ENSURE THE PROTECTION OF THE CAPITAL CITY'S REPUTATION



ACTIVATION



ONCE THESE CONDITIONS ARE AGREED TO AND SAID DOMAIN NAME IS REGISTERED DURING THE LANDRUSH PERIOD, THE REGISTRY WILL SEND A NOTIFICATION IN WRITING OF THIS REGISTRATION TO THE ICANN GOVERNMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE (GAC) CHAIR.
