SPECIFICATION 11 PUBLIC INTEREST COMMITMENTS

1. Registry Operator will use only ICANN accredited registrars that are party to the Registrar Accreditation Agreement approved by the ICANN Board of Directors on [date to be determined at time of contracting], 2013 (or any subsequent form of Registrar Accreditation Agreement approved by the ICANN Board of Directors) in registering domain names. A list of such registrars shall be maintained by ICANN on ICANN's website.

2. Registry Operator will operate the registry for the TLD in compliance with all commitments, statements of intent and business plans stated in the following sections of Registry Operator's application to ICANN for the TLD, which commitments, statements of intent and business plans are hereby incorporated by reference into this Agreement. Registry Operator's obligations pursuant to this paragraph shall be enforceable by ICANN and through the Public Interest Commitment Dispute Resolution Process established by ICANN ((posted at [url to be inserted when final procedure is adopted])), as it may be amended by ICANN from time to time, the "PICDRP"). Registry Operator shall comply with the PICDRP. Registry Operator agrees to implement and adhere to any remedies ICANN imposes (which may include any reasonable remedy, including for the avoidance of doubt, the termination of the Registry Agreement pursuant to Section 4.3(e) of the Registry Agreement) following a determination by any PICDRP panel and to be bound by any such determination.

3. Registry Operator agrees to perform following specific public interest commitments, which commitments shall be enforceable by ICANN and through the PICDRP. Registry Operator shall comply with the PICDRP. Registry Operator agrees to implement and adhere to any remedies ICANN imposes (which may include any reasonable remedy, including for the avoidance of doubt, the termination of the Registry Agreement pursuant to Section 4.3(e) of the Registry Agreement) following a determination by any PICDRP panel and to be bound by any such determination.

- Restrain from lowering wholesale registration or renewal fees for prices under 25 USD.

According to the McAfee report, Mapping the Mal Web, one of the primary reasons of choice that drives spammers, pirates, etc. towards a domain extension is price. Registry Operator commits to maintain prices over 25 USD at all times for single one year terms of registrations or renewals of domain names.

- Contractually commit the designation of the Compliance Officer as stated in sections 28 and 29 of the application, and inform ICANN of contact details of the Officer.

As per sections 28 and 29, Registry Operator commits to designate the Compliance Officer and submit the contact details of the Officer for ICANN review, and public posting. Compliance Officer will produce a state of health report about the extension as detailed later in this specification

- Contract with a recognized third party for the monitoring of activities of malware distribution and unauthorized content distribution in sites under the .LEGAL TLD.

Registry Operator agrees to maintain an agreement with a recognized third party at all times while the Registry Agreement is for the monitoring of activities related to malware, or unauthorized content

distribution in sites under the .LEGAL TLD. Based on the monitoring of the TLD, Registry Operator will engage with Registrars for the takedown or cleanse of the compromised sites, or act on its own behalf to suspend domains being used for the distribution of malware or unauthorized content. Such distribution will be deemed unauthorized or harmful based on the concept of the third party performing the monitoring activity.

- Produce, publish and make available a state of health report for the domain extension with the validation and certification of a respectable third party.

Registry Operator agrees to produce a quarterly report on the health of the sites under the .LEGAL extension. The report will include monitoring, data accuracy and compliance cases and will serve as a reference for the constant improvement of the TLD.
