PUBLIC INTEREST COMMITMENTS (PIC)

2. Registry Operator will operate the registry for the TLD in compliance with all commitments, statements of intent and business plans stated in the following sections of Registry Operator’s application to ICANN for the TLD, which commitments, statements of intent and business plans are hereby incorporated by reference into this Agreement. Registry Operator’s obligations pursuant to this paragraph shall be enforceable by ICANN and through the Public Interest Commitment Dispute Resolution Process established by ICANN (posted at URL to be inserted when final procedure is adopted), as it may be amended by ICANN from time to time, the PICDRP. Registry Operator shall comply with the PICDRP. Registry Operator agrees to implement and adhere to any remedies ICANN imposes (which may include any reasonable remedy, including for the avoidance of doubt, the termination of the Registry Agreement pursuant to Section 4.3(e) of the Registry Agreement) following a determination by any PICDRP panel and to be bound by any such determination.

3. Registry Operator agrees to perform following specific public interest commitments, which commitments shall be enforceable by ICANN and through the PICDRP. Registry Operator shall comply with the PICDRP. Registry Operator agrees to implement and adhere to any remedies ICANN imposes (which may include any reasonable remedy, including for the avoidance of doubt, the termination of the Registry Agreement pursuant to Section 4.3(e) of the Registry Agreement) following a determination by any PICDRP panel and to be bound by any such determination.

PIC # 1

DotGreen Community, Inc. (DGC) will commit to being flexible in its business plan, technical operations and policies as market conditions change for the purpose of creating a sustainable business model to operate .GREEN, as an environmental TLD, and to follow the motivations and intent of its Founder and the professional team behind the application.

PIC # 2

The Board Directors, Executives and Officers who make decisions on behalf of DGC will not be Directors or Officers of a corporation which is known to have violated international environmental law.

PIC # 3

The Board Directors, Executives, and Officers of the DGC will not have a confirmed history of Cybersquatting.

PIC # 4

DGC has spent over five years working with the green community to focus on only one TLD (.GREEN) and has taken a leadership role to earn the support of this community (evidenced in the ICANN New gTLD Application Public Comments) in order to best serve the public interest. DGC commits to continuing its leadership role as the operator of the .GREEN TLD.

PIC # 5

DGC will publish on its website in an open and transparent manner the organizations which receive donations from a portion of the proceeds of the sale of .GREEN domain names for Sustainability, Environmental and Humanitarian programs and projects.

PIC # 6

DGC commits to the green business principal of gender equity in the 21st century and will support Board Director, Executive and Officer roles held by women and men which is widely recognized as an important component of Corporate Social Responsibility.

PIC # 7

Via a contact link on its website, DGC will be open to collaboration with governments around the world interested in adopting and using .GREEN domain names in a manner that will advance sustainability in their respective regions. DGC will also reserve the required country and territory names at the second level.

PIC # 8

DGC believes in the protection of intellectual property rights and will implement the mandatory rights protection mechanisms (RPMs) contained in the Applicant Guidebook including:

- Trademark Clearinghouse
- Sunrise and Trademark Claims process
- Implementation of the Uniform Dispute Resolution Policy
- Uniform Rapid Suspension
